DEVELOPMENT UPDATES



Construction on our super exciting new dining and entertainment precinct is progressing well and is still on track for our estimated opening of November 2019.

Piling will continue to progress through the Northern Carpark and you will notice changes to our traffic management during this time. As part of this, the installation of a temporary gantry will maintain pedestrian access into the centre from this carpark.

Void infill works above Bed Bath N Table and the food court will commence in February. Works will be completed after trade with dust covers to protect all ground and level one tenancies.

Construction will commence in a portion of the Level 1 undercover carpark to begin building the new mini major tenancy which will result in the closure of 50 carparks.

In March, you will see further impact to the centre including the Food Court closing for 4 weeks to allow for a full renovation of this area. This will include refurbishments to furniture, ceiling finishes and refurbishments to many of the tenants. The Food Court will reopen in early April 2019. Pop up will incorporate some foodies to ensure takeaway food is still an option for our customers. Existing foodies, please prepare for this closure. You will see an increase in customers to your store while the food court is closed and you may want to look at introducing some quicker takeaway food options to your menus.
