DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Construction UPSTAIRS has ramped up recently in the Bunnings / Petbarn carpark. If you have driven down Masefield Street, you would have noticed that concrete was poured to create the slab for the external plaza UPSTAIRS.

You will also notice some changes internally on Level 1 later this month. Hoarding will be installed around the voids in front of the cinema and McDonald's so that the voids can be partially infilled. Access to Level 1 via the travelators and the temporary staircase will remain during this time.
